VINTAGE NOTES:

The 2006 vintage in the Willamette Valley will be remembered as a harvest defined by heat and low yields that pushed the fruit to near record ripeness levels and produced wines of dramatic intensity and concentration.

TASTING NOTES:

Vibrant, blood-red color underlines pleasing aromatics of wild raspberries, jasmine and licorice. A full and round palate makes one think of 'rum & raisin' chocolate, juicy berries and cassis. The tannins while substantial are soft and in fact almost voluptuous.
