WILLAMETTE VALLEY SEVEN SOILS CHARDONNAY

APPELLATION: Willamette Valley

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Chardonnay

VINEYARD SOURCES: Varied

CELLAR TREATMENT: Fermented and aged 11 months in 90% nuetral/

10% new French oak, rested for 3 months in stainless steel after

PRODUCTION: ~450 cases annually

DESCRIPTION: A BLEND OF CHARDONNAY FROM SELECT WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS CHOSEN FOR COMPLEXITY, FERMENTED AND AGED IN SMALL FRENCH OAK BARRELS FOR DEPTH AND LONGEVITY.

TASTING: COMPLEX AND BRIGHT, WITH NOTES OF LEMON PEEL, CREAM, APPLE AND WHITE FLOWERS.

PAIRING: THIS WINE IS AMAZING WITH SHELLFISH AND RICH, CREAMY CHEESES.

KEY POINTS:

Aged in 90% small, neutral, French oak barrels for 11 months, blended into stainless steel vats, and rested for an additional three months for full integration and flavor development.

At least seven soils are represented each vintage. The number seven has long been considered lucky and sometimes an indication of perfection.





WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR

APPELLATION: Willamette Valley

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD SOURCES: 70% Estate, 30% carefully chosen

vineyards across the Willamette valley AVA

CELLAR TREATMENT: French oak, aged 11 months, 20% new oak

PRODUCTION: ~3,500 cases annually

DESCRIPTION: THE REX HILL WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR EXPRESSES LAYERS OF FRUIT, FLORAL NOTES, A HINT OF EARTHINESS AND A DEVELOPED MID-PALATE.

TASTING: BOLD AND FRUIT-FORWARD WITH FIRM TANNINS AND EXPRESSIVE AROMAS OF BLACK CHERRY, PLUM, LAVENDER, ROSE, SWEET TOBACCO AND A HINT OF EARTHINESS.

PAIRING: PAIR WITH PORK AND CHICKEN-BASED DISHES, ESPECIALLY THOSE WITH MUSHROOM OR CHERRY SAUCE FINISHES.

CHEHALEM MOUNTAINS PINOT NOIR

APPELLATION: Chehalem Mountains, Willamette Valley

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD SOURCES: 59% Jacob-Hart, 35% Alloro 6% REX HILL Estate

CELLAR TREATMENT: French oak, aged 11 months, 30% new oak

PRODUCTION: ~400 cases annually

DESCRIPTION: A BLEND OF PINOT NOIR FROM OUR FINEST VINEYARDS LOCATED WITHIN JUST 5 MILES OF THE WINERY, INCLUDING OUR REX HILL ESTATE VINEYARD.

TASTING: RICH AND FULL BODIED WITH NOTES OF CHERRY, PLUM, POMEGRANATE AND HINTS OF SAVORY HERBS AND WHITE PEPPER.

PAIRING: PAN-ROASTED SALMON, PORK LOIN, PASTA BOLOGNESE

The Chehalem Mountains AVA is incredibly diverse, with a myriad of soil types and the highest elevation sites within the Willamette Valley AVA.

This wine offers exceptional value for the price, incorporating three of our best vineyards located nearest the REX HILL winery, all priced independently higher than the Chehalem Mountains Pinot Noir blend.





JACOB-HART VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

APPELLATION: Chehalem Mountains, Willamette Valley

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD SOURCES & CLONES: 100% Jacob-Hart (34% Pommard,

35% 777, 11% Field Blend, 11% Wädenswil, 9% 667 Clones)

CELLAR TREATMENT: French oak, aged 11 months, 30% new oak

PRODUCTION: ~450 cases annually

DESCRIPTION: THE JACOB-HART VINEYARD, PURCHASED IN 1987, IS NAMED AFTER REX HILL'S FOUNDERS, JAN JACOBSEN & PAUL HART. AN OLD TURKEY FARM, THE LAND WAS WELL SUITED TO GROWING GRAPES AND SOIL STUDIES HAVE DETERMINED THERE ARE AT LEAST 13 SOIL TYPES ON THE PROPERTY. LOCATED ON A WARM SOUTHEAST-FACING SLOPE OF THE CHEHALEM RIDGE, FRUIT AT THIS VINEYARD IS HARVESTED A WEEK OR TWO BEFORE OTHER REX HILL PINOT NOIR SITES.

TASTING: PEPPER, EARTH, MUSHROOM, CHERRY & MARIONBERRY WITH FINE-GRAINED STRUCTURED TANNINS.

PAIRING: LAMB CHOPS, FILET MIGNON, MUSHROOM SAUCES
